We trust that you are all doing well, and God has kept you safe since the sudden closure of the Universities by the Government in March 2020. We would like to inform you that the University Governing Council, Senate, Management, staff and other stakeholders have been working hard to find a solution that can allow teaching and learning to continue for our students. We are proud to confirm that KHU has developed an eLearning/Online learning system (KHU ODeL LMS) which becomes effective first week of September 2020. Currently, all the necessary training for faculty and staff is ongoing. Student training will commence shortly, and this will be communicated through the University website.

This memo is therefore to notify all KHU students to register for the 2020 September online classes through the University Academic Management System (AMIS) so that you can be Registered for classes in KHU ODeL System. The deadline for Registration in AMIS is 3rd September 2020. Only those students who will have registered in AMIS will be able to access the ODeL System subject to clearance by Finance Office. It is important that you provide the correct information (i.e. names, registration number, and working phone number). Please refer to the requirements for ODeL Registration's memo *KHU/ODEL/2020/1(02)* on the University website for more details.

We welcome all of you back to the classroom through KHU ODeL as we wait for the resumption of face-to-face classes when Universities reopen countrywide. The University through the ODeL Office has sufficient support for both our students and staff to ensure a smooth transition to the new mode of learning.
