HIGHER EDUCATION LOANS BOARD (HELB)

It is advisable that all students admitted to Universities in Kenya apply for loan from The Higher Education Loans Board (HELB). Visit HELB website “www.helb.co.ke” and apply online. All students who are given admission offer this year are advised to use details in the admission letter to apply for HELB funding regardless of reporting date. You should familiarize yourself with HELB requirements from their website.

JOINING INSTRUCTION

Registration form provides students with vital information and is also used for documenting students’ biodata. You are required to complete all relevant sections of the form and submit it at the point of registration.

ACCOMMODATION


The university has limited accommodation rooms which are highly competitive at a cost of Kshs 6,000 per semester; the Dean of Students has a supplementary list of privately managed hostels which charge between Kshs 6,000 and Kshs 9,000 per semester for accommodation. All students should have secured accommodation and settled by 4th September 2020 to enable them attend classes.
